Benedict XVI's 5 Ways of Demonstrating the Existence of God

In the Summa Theologiae, St. Thomas Aquinas famously offers his "qunique viae", or "five ways," for demonstrating the existence of God. Throughout the work of Joseph Ratzinger /Benedict XVI, we find five other ways for demonstrating the existence of God.

Over the course of his public career, he variously pointed to (1) science (and the intelligibility of the universe more broadly); (2) the meaning of life; (3) philosophy, and particularly, great philosophical questions like "where does everything come from?"; (4) the witness of the Saints; and (5) the role of beauty.

Of these last two, then-Cardinal Ratzinger once observed that "the only really effective apologia for Christianity comes down to two arguments, namely the saints the Church has produced and the art which has grown in her womb."

So how do these five things point to God, and how can we present these in a compelling way to the non-believers in our lives?



Also, last month, I had the privilege to welcome to the Parousia office the youth from the Syro Malabar Eparchy, who were very impressive and I am looking forward to working with them. We also caught up with our friends at **Shalom World** who are partnering with us on our Parousia live events. Look out for more videos produced by them.
