She briefly stopped in Sydney to visit our office, along with the movement's English coordinator, **Carolina Cetenareski**, to record a podcast with us. Angela started this movement in Brazil and this year alone they had **over 150,000 mothers** attend their conferences. That's right - three zeros! It was a huge turn out here and they are going from strength to strength. Please pray for this important movement, which is in the process of becoming officially recognised by the Vatican.

I look forward to joining the conference next year as a speaker. As you may know, if it wasn't for my own mother's prayers, I personally would not be here today. Parousia is excited to announce the launch of Angela's first book (in English) called **Mothers who Pray for their Children: By God's Inspiration**. The second major event we were involved with was with **Damian Stayne**, hosted by the *Servants of Jesus*. Damian is from England and is the author of the book **Renew Your Wonders: Spiritual Gifts for Today**. He has dedicated his life to serving the Church and has been promoting the gift of healing and prophecy that is available to every baptised person. He reminds us of how God performs miracles today and how we should expect this to continue. 

The Woman | *St Anthony Communications*



In the Gospels we hear Jesus refer to his mother Mary as "Woman". This reference should draw our attention to the woman mentioned in Genesis, as well as in the book of Revelation. But who is this "Woman", and **why is she so central in the history of Salvation?**


This powerful film considers the Catholic teaching about Mary, the mother of Jesus, and her important role in the Church and in the lives of Christians today. The dogmas of Mother of God, Immaculate Conception, Perpetual Virginity, and Assumption are explained along with other traditional beliefs and devotions to Mary.

Insightful commentary is provided by Fr Marcus Holden, Fr Andrew Pinsent, Sr Mary of the Trinity, Fr Jeff Steel, and Joanna Bogle, along with a number of young people speaking about their faith and love of Our Blessed Lady.

I also want to mention the special event that took place on the birthday of **St Charbel. St Charbel's Monastery** holds a special place in my heart as it was the church where I was baptised, confirmed and married my wife Christine. Christine attended **St Charbel's College** and I first met her at *Guardians* which is held at **St Charbel's Church**. Our first four children were baptised in the Monastery and, as you may know, Parousia has held some of our biggest events there. The Monastery celebrates **50 years in Australia** and to celebrate, the monks from the **Lebanese Maronite Order** organised a porcelain replica of St Charbel in a coffin, matching his tomb in Lebanon. They also have a piece of his bone placed in the heart of the replica and a stained white robe inside the tomb. This is a first class relic of the great saint and the monastery is now an official shrine of St Charbel. Only the second ever outside of Lebanon. Congratulations to the Lebanese Maronite Order and the monks of St Charbel's Monastery. I owe my life to this saint who saved me in my mothers womb and we understand **his miracles have grown to over 40,000** in number. **St Charbel, pray for us.**





Dr Robert M. Haddad holds qualifications in law, theology, philosophy and religious education, including a MA (Theo.), MRelEd, M.
